Successful Co-Parenting: Helping Children Cope With Divorce



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What is it?

Helping Children Cope with Divorce is a two and one-half hour educational program which offers information on the divorce process and post-divorce parenting. In cooperation with the Perry County Common Pleas Court, the program is conducted by a qualified professional from Ohio State University Extension, Perry County.



Who Should Attend?

All parents seeking a divorce or dissolution and having children under 18 years of age are required to attend. Divorcing parents are required to the first session after the answer date in each particular divorce proceeding or a session prior to their final hearing for dissolution. Failure of a party to attend a parenting session as ordered above may result in a dismissal of the case or a failure to obtain visitation rights until said parenting session is successfully completed.
