2024 4-H Camp Information

Why 4-H Camp? Camp teaches kids basic life skills, forces them to disconnect and build face-to-face relationships, promotes independence, *and can be one of the best parts of being a kid!*

Camperships – If your family needs additional financial support to send your 4-H'er(s) to camp this summer, PLEASE complete the online application by May 10th! www.go.osu.edu/perrycampership

Counselors & Staff - 4-H Camp Ohio has both permanent and summer adult staff members. Additionally, Perry County brings several other adult staff members, including the 4-H Extension Educator and a full-time nurse. There will also be 35+ local, trained teen counselors.

Camp Facilities & Dining - Campers and Counselors are housed in cabins that sleep 10 to 15. Clean central toilet and shower facilities are available on the boys' side and girls' side of camp. Camp offers over 200 acres for nature study and recreation areas - a wide variety of programs are offered. Other facilities include a dining hall, recreation hall, swimming pool, nature center, craft hall, ball fields, adult staff cabins, and MORE! Meals are prepared and served in the central dining hall, and special dietary needs can be accommodated with advance notice. Snacks are served each evening.

Cabin Assignments - Campers will be housed with others of about the same age & grade. Requests from campers to be with friends will be honored, if at all possible. ***The request must appear on both campers' registration forms.***

What to Bring? - Upon receiving your camp registration and fee, a health form, information about what to bring and directions to Camp will be sent. **Health forms MUST be submitted ahead of time & ALL medication(s) must be given to the camp nurse upon check-in.**

NEW High Ropes Course! - Camp Ohio's awesome new course is full of challenging obstacles 20 feet above the ground! The course is designed for individuals who desire the ultimate in challenge & group involvement. High Ropes is optional for campers **12 years or older** and is led by a trained, certified instructor. All safety equipment is included. Cost for this 2-3 hour course is an additional \$20.00 and must be included with your camp registration & camp fee.

Transportation - Parents are responsible for transportation to and from Camp. Scheduled arrival for check-in will be from 8:00 - 10:00am on Saturday, June 22 and scheduled pick-up will be from 9:30 - 10:30am on Tuesday, June 25. Scheduled times for check-in and pick-up will be sent once your camper registers, along with their health form and other details!
